# CONSTITUTION

## CONSTITUTION

## Article 1 – Organization

#### Section 1 – Name

- A. The name of this organization shall be: *Quartzsite Roadrunners Gem & Mineral Club, Inc.*
- **B.** Articles of Incorporation under this name shall be recorded at the Court House in Parker, La Paz County, Arizona.

#### Section 2 – Purpose

- **A.** The purpose of this organization is to arouse and maintain an enthusiastic interest in the study of gems and minerals and to learn new and better methods of lapidary work.
- **B.** It is the desire of this organization to promote better knowledge of natural earth science to the general public, to protect and stop the waste of our natural resources.
- **C.** This club shall have the right to acquire, hold, manage, lease, sell or dispose of such facilities, properties, or services as may be necessary to properly attain the object.
- **D.** The Quartzsite Roadrunners Gem & Mineral Club shall not act for members in political, religious, or sectarian matters to engage in such matters.

#### Section 3 – Membership

- **A.** The membership of this club shall not be limited. Anyone interested in the study, and/or the working or gathering of specimens, gems, or minerals, is eligible for membership.
- **B.** No one may use any shop equipment or participate in any classes or instructions promoted by the Quartzsite Roadrunners Gem & Mineral Club until they have attained the legal age as defined by the State of Arizona.

## Article 2 – Officers

#### Section 1 – Officers and Trustees

- A. The election of officers shall be by paper ballot at the third meeting in January.
- **B.** The newly elected officers shall assume their duties at the first meeting in March. They shall consist of President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Board of Trustees.
- **C.** Each officer except those on the Board of Trustees is elected for a term of one (1) year and may be reelected. None may serve more than four (4) consecutive terms in the same position. Officers may run for office again after a one (1) year absence from office. Any officer may run for other positions at any time.
- **D.** The Board of Trustees shall be elected for a three (3) year term. None shall be elected for more than one (1) term but may run again after a one (1) year absence from the position of Trustee.
- **E.** Only one member of any family may serve as an officer of this organization at the same time.

### Section 2 – Meetings

**A.** Meetings shall be held weekly on Thursday at 2:00 PM starting on the last Thursday in October and continuing through the last Thursday in March at the QIA building or any other membership location.

### Article 3 - Amendments

#### <u>Section 1 – Constitution</u>

**A.** Articles, sections, or parts of this constitution may be deleted, added to, or changed by the following procedure.

- 1. The part to be added changed or deleted shall be read by the secretary at the business meeting of this club.
- A three fourths (3/4) majority by paper ballot by those present will be considered valid for any change in the constitution. At least one hundred twenty five (125) must be present before a vote can be taken.
- 3. On the legislative or judicial points of law not covered by this constitution, the officers and members will decide procedure according to the Robert's Rules of Order, the latest revised edition.
- 4. All changes in the constitution must be brought before the

Board of Directors before being presented to the membership for ratification.

## Article 4 – Succession of Power

Section 1 – Subsection 2

A The succession of power shall be as follows: President – Vice President – Secretary – Treasurer.
